Policy Statement

The Board has a responsibility to hold itself accountable for the overall performance of its responsibilities and to evaluate its effectiveness.

In a positive, constructive environment board members will provide information to the Board Chair for the purpose of identifying actions to improve individual board member performance and to improve the performance of the Board.

The evaluation of individual board members will be done on an annual basis in a self-evaluation format developed and modified from time to time.

The second aspect of the evaluation is to monitor the performance of the Board. This part of the evaluation will be carried out on an annual basis. The evaluation is based on the responsibilities as outlined in the various sections of the Yukon College Board Handbook and in the format attached to this policy.
