



YUKON SCHOOL OF VISUAL ARTS (SOVA) CANADA/USA SCHOLARSHIP

Scholarship Overview

The Yukon School of Visual Arts (SOVA) offers one scholarship per year to a deserving applicant whose permanent residence is in Canada or the United States. This award acknowledges excellence in the area of visual arts and is intended to attract the most accomplished students from across North America to SOVA's foundation year program.

Eligibility Information

If you would like to be considered for the **SOVA-Canada/USA Scholarship** of \$1,000, please check mark the appropriate box on the Application Form and include the following materials with your application package:

- **Proof of Residency:** Please submit a photocopy or digital scan of a piece of government issued identification (ie: passport, driver's license, health card).
- **3rd Portfolio Assignment:** Submit a 3rd portfolio assignment from the Portfolio Assignment List. Make sure it is labeled with your name. (see Portfolio Submission instructions for details)

In order to be considered for a SOVA-Yukon Scholarship, **ALL** regular Application Materials along with proof of residency and an additional portfolio assignment must be submitted by **March 31st**.

Awarding a Recipient

A panel of SOVA's Administration and Faculty reviews Scholarship Applications. Scholarships are awarded based on the strength of the applicant's portfolio submission, grades, statement of intent, and letter of recommendation. All decisions are final.

Scholarship Conditions

In order to receive payment of scholarship funds, the winner must:

- Register as a full-time student in the foundation year program at Yukon School of Visual Arts.
- Maintain full-time student status throughout the Fall and Winter terms (ie. 4 course minimum).
- Maintain a B average in the Fall and Winter terms.

Method of Implementation

The successful applicant will be notified by June 30th prior to each school year. The scholarships will be awarded in two payments of \$500 each on September 15th (Fall term) and January 15th (Winter term).

- If the Award winner fails to maintain full-time student status and a B average in the Fall term, the Winter term award payment will be withheld.
- A scholarship may not be awarded to the same student twice.
