# WELCOME TO THE YUKON NATIVE TEACHER EDUCATION PROGRAM

Before you complete the application form please read the following:

The Yukon Native Teacher Education Program (YNTEP) is designed to foster the development of cross-cultural and Yukon First Nations' perspectives in public school classrooms throughout the Yukon. YNTEP is a four-year program leading to a Bachelor of Education degree; graduates from the program qualify for both Saskatchewan and Yukon Teacher Certification. The program is intended for full time studies and is comprised of a fall & winter semester as well as a summer cultural camp.

YNTEP is not structured to support after degree programming.

## ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

Grade 12 academic graduation with a 65% G.P.A. in English 12 and either Principles of Math 11 or 12 or Applications of Math 12 and one Language or Social Science or Fine Arts course at the grade 12 level plus two additional grade 12 level courses and acceptable scores on the Language Proficiency Index test [LPI];

or 21 years of age or older

English 090 with grade of B or higher or acceptable scores on the Language Proficiency Index test [LPI]; and

Successful completion of Math 050 or Math 042.

Notes:

- All applicants must meet the University of Regina's admission requirements to qualify for entrance into YNTEP.
- If you do not meet admission requirements, please contact YNTEP meet with an advisor who can help plan a program of studies to meet admission requirements.

2. One reference from a close acquaintance of yours whom can provide a character reference. This letter may be mailed by the reference source directly to the Admissions office at the address given above.
3. A letter from a First Nation educator or official supporting your aspirations to teach in a cross-cultural First Nations' setting. This letter may be mailed by the First Nation educator or official directly to the Admissions office at the address given above.
4. A current resume highlighting your employment, community service & volunteer work, noting experience working with children and Youth where appropriate.
5. **Two transcripts from your high school and all post-secondary educational institutions you attended.** You must arrange with the principal and/or registrar of the institution to mail your transcript directly to: **(1)** The Registrar of Yukon College, at the address given above; and **(2)** the Registrar of the University of Regina, Regina, Saskatchewan, S4S 0A2. There may be a fee attached to this service, which you will be responsible for.
6. Consent for Disclosure of Criminal Record Information –Process for this information:
  - Take 2 pieces of identification (one picture) to your local RCMP detachment;
  - Inform the RCMP representative that you need a criminal records check for entry into a Teacher Education Program (YNTEP)
  - Fill out the *Consent for Disclosure of Criminal Record Information* form;
  - Fill out *Appendix P* form;
