YukonU Financial statements and OAG report

FARC met with OAG team to review the YukonU financial statements and audit report. Overall, the consolidated financial statements are free of material misstatement.

2022-23 Supplemental budget

Information was presented to the Board on the 2021-22 surplus

- \$754,357 operational surplus
- Cover costs associated with prior IT equipment commitments
- YG Education is aware of surplus and is indicating that carry-over is not an issue

MOVED by Joel Cubley, SECONDED by James Allen that the Board of Governors approves \$754,357 as a supplement to the 2022-23 budget and approves the expenditure of those funds. CARRIED.

Polaris project update

Zero-carbon building registration:

- YukonU is committed to sustainability
- Zero-Carbon building registration allows for certification of a building's zero carbon status
- Could be Yukon's first zero carbon building
- If there are any financial implications, recommendations will need to be brought back to FARC
- Energy savings over time

MOVED by Jason Bilsky SECONDED by Sarah Newton that the Board of Governors approves the Polaris project to plan towards a zero-carbon facility within approved budget. CARRIED.
